Online Professional Development Modules

Overview:

The four online modules are designed to provide potential MAS instructors with the skills and knowledge needed to successfully carry out the project goals, objectives, and activities. The goal of this online training is to enrich your knowledge of innovative instructional strategies for migrant students both for MAS and beyond the scope of the project.

Each facilitated module is divided into five weeks with required readings and participation in moderated discussions each week. Teachers may enroll in one or more modules. ***There is no cost to participating MAS districts.***

 - Skill Building
- **April 19, 2010 – May 16, 2010**
 - Balanced Literacy
